

Format: You Pick Your Three events from the following. Scores from each event will be totaled to determine our Top Shot.

Some important rules:

- All participants MUST be registered prior to shooting for scores.
- All participants MUST wear eye and ear protection.
- All participants MUST follow the commands given by the Range Officer
- All guns will be unloaded and cased until such time as the Range Officer calls participants to the line at which time the Range Officer will give the command to uncase and load.
- All weapons will be pointed DOWN RANGE once the command to load is given.



Rifle Event: .22 caliber rifle, scoped or iron sights. Standing / Offhand (no support) shots at <u>metal</u> targets at 25 yds.5 shots for score.



Pistol Event: any caliber handgun, scoped, aimpoints, or iron sights. Standing / Offhand (no support) shots at metal dueling target at 15 yards. 5 shots for score.



Shotgun Event: Any gauge shotgun. Trap field firing at 5 clay birds for score from different positions.



Archery Event: Any kind of bow. Take 4 shots at balloons at various distances. 1 shot at bullseye target at long distance.

Total score determines winner. Tie breakers will be 100 yard shot with .22 caliber rifle (offhand/standing) at a balloon until someone misses.

Prize money will as follows:

1st place: 30% of pot 2nd place: 15% of pot. 3rd place: 5% of pot.
