The total dry score is $194 \frac{4}{8}$ and net with deductions it is $181 \frac{7}{8}$. This is the biggest in Ulster County this year by 20 inches. It was 219 lbs. dressed and had a 33 inch neck and 60 inch chest. It took five of us to carry it up the hill. Klaus took it down with his .243 rifle and it took two shots. They are expecting it to be in the top five largest bucks ever recorded in NY State.

On the 23rd, 24th and 25th of January they are having the outdoor show at the state fairgrounds in Syracuse. Klaus was invited to showcase his buck for all 3 days , all expenses paid.

Klaus is enjoying the exposure.
