Shooting starts at 5:30 and ends by 7:30 or when we run out of ammo. call me with questions--Bob vogel Sr 845 206 6784



6:00pm to 8:00pm, prior to the meeting



#### CHICHESTER CAMP RULES

- 1. Only officers will have keys (4). Must check with officer to register for camp ahead of time. Get key from officer that lives nearest to you.
- 2. Limit of (2) nights, if more time desired you must call officer for additional nights.
- 3. All members must sign in and out with day, and dates, trailers must also be registered.
- 4. Any defects must be reported to officer when you get back.
- 5. All garbage must be brought back with you.
- 6. No water to be turned on in winter months, after December 5.
- 7. No shooting on property and no loaded weapons in camp.
- 8. No rowdiness, drunkeness, violence or loudness.
- 9. Buttons (Bethlehem membership) must be worn.
- 10. Use only designated crossing for fishing; respect property owners and their property. Do not cross private property for any reason, unless you get owners permission first.
- 11. Howard Brown is in charge of camp work parties.
- 12. All pots and pans, dishes, silverware, etc. shall be cleaned, dried and put away before leaving.
- 13. All furniture and beds shall be left in a clean, orderly condition.
- 14. Be certain all smoking products are extinguished, and all ash trays cleaned.
- 15. Before leaving turn off all electricity, including lights and stoves, also water must be shut off.
- 16. Be sure all doors and windows are locked before leaving.
  - 17. Do not litter outside of building.
- 18. ANY MEMBER WHO VIOLATES THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY EXPELLED FROM THE CLUB.

In true camping spirit, leave it as clean as you would like to find it.
