Range Hours During Trap Sessions

At the April meeting, it was voted to keep the rifle / pistol range open during trap on the scheduled days (Sunday and Monday).

The discussion was premised on using the hand held, manual release because the voice release is activated by rifle / pistol.

After discussion with the trap chairman, it was learned that the trap machine isn't designed to use the manual release as a primary method for shooting trap.

Our trap machine is designed to be used with voice activation.

At the May meeting. All the facts were brought to the membership and a motion was made to go back to the long standing rule that has rifle / pistol closed during the scheduled trap hours.

A good discussion, with time for questions and answers ensued.

A vote was taken and the motion was voted in. Rifle / pistol will be closed during scheduled trap shooting.
