ARCHERY RANGE

Sign in when you use the range or 3D course at the sign in station. Guests must pay a \$10 fee and be accompanied by a regular member. The range is in good shape, there are yard markers for 10, 20, 30, 40, 50 & 60 yards. The archery range is currently open from sunrise to sunset. Crossbows may be used on the range (bag targets only). Use crossbow bolts and arrows with field points only. Styrofoam blocks that have been tied together may be used as a target for broadheads. The yellow chain is to stay up to designate a possible live archery range.





3D RANGE

The 3D course is closed. Remember, it is hunting season and there are people hunting along the trails on the ridge. I am currently working on a slide show of the course. Special Thanks to everyone who participated in and or helped with the 3D shoots and maintaining the course and range.

10-14 Years old Carl Foti-Largest Fish




