VOTING RESULTS FOR 2018 BYLAWS – MARCH 26, 2018

Approved	For	Against	Article	Proposed 2018 Bylaws Wording
NO	42	42	3	Annual Dues are as follows: <u>\$150.00</u> – Adult member (18 years of age or older) <u>\$ 75.00</u> – Senior members age 65 or older
YES	57	26		1. All new Adult and Senior members shall pay a one-time <u>initiation fee of \$250.00 in addition to their first year's dues.</u>
YES	76	5		<u>7. Junior members and guests shall be supervised by an adult member at all times while on club property or participating in club events.</u>
YES	75	8	4	2. All monies generated by club functions must be turned over to <u>the Financial Secretary or in his/her absence any club officer within thirty five days (35) of receiving such monies. A written receipt shall be issued by the officer accepting the monies.</u>
YES	74	10		<u>A quorum of one-tenth of the total number of votes entitled to be cast by the membership, plus two Officers in good standing is required for any member meeting.</u>
YES	75	6		<u>Matters, excluding bylaws, voted on by the membership shall be determined by simple majority vote.</u>
YES	78	6	6	Proposed candidates for Office must be a member in good standing for at least two years, and have attended 50% of the current years (Jan-Sept) monthly meetings. If a qualified member has been nominated for an open Officer/Director position, no exceptions for unqualified members shall be allowed. In the event of no qualified member being nominated for an open position, exceptions to the requirements shall be made by a majority vote of the members present at the September meeting when nominations are made.
YES	80	5	18	<u>Standard of Conduct: Members and Guests</u> <u>1. No member shall, through their actions, conduct or tumultuous behavior, endanger the safety, welfare, interest of, or in any way cause harm to the club or any of its members.</u>
