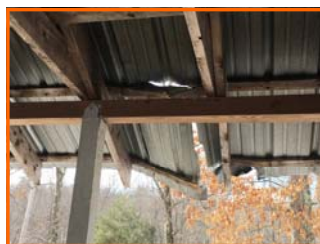
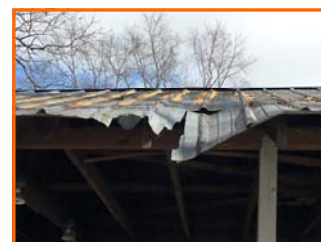

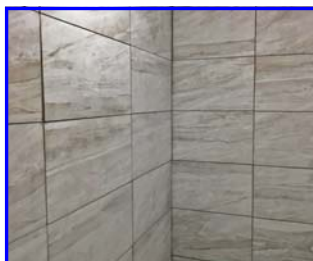
Fish Sanctuaries

BY-LAW VOTE FEBRUARY MEMBERSHIP MEETING RESULTS

All three proposed By-Law changes that were presented for discussion at the January membership meeting were passed, per our By-Laws, by a 2/3 majority vote of the members present at the February 25th membership meeting. Changes listed by Article;

Article 3--In addition to annual dues all Adult and Senior members will (every year) pay \$25.00 for a Building/Land Raffle when dues are paid.

Building/Land raffle payout will be held annually at the January membership meeting with one \$1,000.00 and one \$500.00 drawings.

Balance of collected funds are to be placed, yearly, in a "Restricted use" Building/land account.

Article 7--The Board of Directors are now required to Audit the books of the Treasurer and Financial Sec quarterly.

Article 9--Assessment for work hours not worked is now \$15.00

Adult members must perform 8 work hours and Senior members 4 hours.

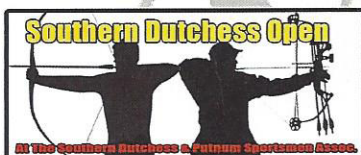

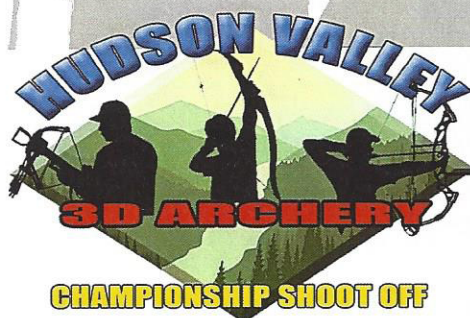
