Repair 5picnic tables

- Add deck boards underneath to strengthen and prevent warping.
 - Pressure treated deck boards
 - 2" screws
- Border the ends
 - Rip a 2x to boarder the table and seating ends
 - 3"screws
 - Belt sand table, edges and seating to create an even smooth surface
 - Wipe it clean and Paint

Paint the big table under the pavilion and paint it along with the 4x4 posts supporting the pavilion.

Build (hanging) barn doors to close in the tractor area.Add header for track

- 2x4 framing (2 doors)
- T-111 sheathing
- Paint

Repair the Kioti mower deck

- Bend the brackets straight
- Weld on additional supports
- Clean and paint the welds

Weld the Kioti back hoe

- The mounting frame to the hoe
- Clean and paint the welds

Wash the tractor

- Car wash brush with degreaser soap
- Pressure wash
- Once clean, we'll have someone do the yearly maintenance

Put battery back in riding mower

- Change oil
- Air Filter (check for mice, clean, replace if necessary)
- New Gas
- Run it for several minutes
- Wash it

Add springs and pistons on the storm door located in the front of the club house.

Work party being planned to ...

Move all firewood under overhang and stack high.

Rake leaves

Pick rocks from all mowed areas
