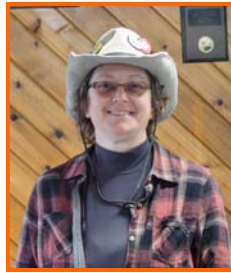

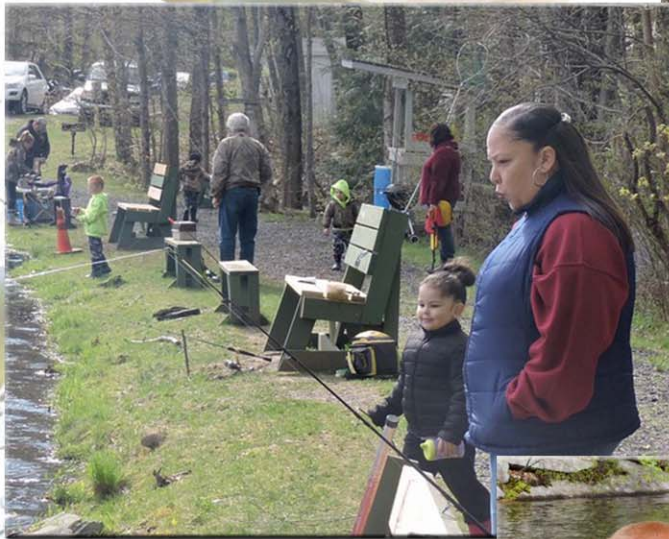

To Do List

Paint (hanging) barn doors that are closing in the tractor area.

Repair the Kioti mower deck

- Bend the brackets straight
- Weld on additional supports
- Clean and paint the welds

Weld the Kioti back hoe

- The mounting frame to the hoe
- Clean and paint the welds

Stack firewood pile at the end of the pavilion, moving it under the overhang and stack high.

Get on the volunteer list to work on the road (a work party date to be determined).

- Fill low spots with ¾" stone
- Vibrate down with power tamper
