

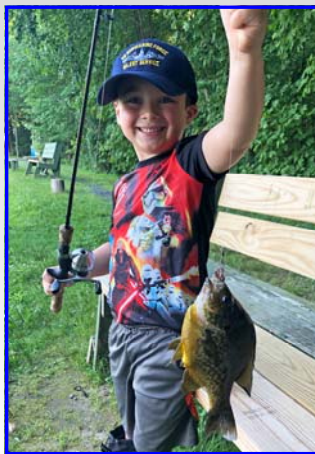

ARCHERY NEWS



The Archery Committee, BobHilerio, VinnyDeLongis, Gene DeLongis, Phil Malle, Dennis Santiago, Scott Mandoske, Tim Ryder, Darren Orzechowski and myself placed 28, 3-D targets for the membership to use. The trail is clearly marked and the stations are clearly numbered. All stations have a bow rack. If you see bows on a rack, **DO NOT** shoot that station, archers may be looking for an arrow

When using the archery target area and the animal 3-D target course please: Sign the log book in the archery mailbox, use only field tips (no broad heads or bolts/crossbow), place found arrows at mailbox, place any suggestions in the mailbox.

Bethlehem Rod and Gun Club will be hosting a 3-D shoot on August 11th, and September 15th2019. There will be no charge for BRGC club members (must present membership card). Fee for non-members will be \$12. Registration will start 7:00 and end 12:00. Food and beverages will be available at club house. Volunteers will be needed to help with registration, kitchen and targets (good way to get your work hours).
