Bethlehem Rod & Gun Club Sportsmen's Challenge September 7, 2019 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Format: You Pick Your Three events from the following. Scores from each event will be totaled to determine our Top Shot.

Some important rules:

- All participants MUST be registered prior to shooting for scores.
- All participants MUST wear eye and ear protection.
- All participants MUST follow the commands given by the Range Officer.
- All guns MUST be cased or holstered, when travelling to your selected events or you will be disqualified.
- All guns will be unloaded and cased until such time as the Range Officer calls participants to the line at which time the Range Officer will give the command to uncase and load.
- All weapons will be pointed DOWN RANGE once the command to load is given.
- Pistol Shooters MUST have a valid NYS pistol permit and produce it on demand from the Range Officer.
- Total score determines winner. Tie breaker is TBD.



Rifle Event: .22 caliber rifle, scoped or iron sights. Standing / Offhand (no support) shots at <u>metal</u> targets at 25 yards. 15 shots for score.



Pistol Event: Any caliber handgun, scoped, aimpoints, or iron sights. Standing / Offhand (no support) shots at <u>metal</u> plates and/or rubber spinners at various distances from 10-25 yards. 15 shots for score.



Shotgun Event: Any gauge shotgun. Trap field firing at 15 clay birds from 5 different positions for score.



Archery Events: Pick your bow – **Compound or Traditional**. 15 shots at five 3D targets at various distances.



Centerfire Rifle Events: 5 shots at a steel target at 100 yards. No green tip ammo.

Prize money will as follows:

1st place: 30% of pot 2nd place: 15% of pot. 3rd place: 5% of pot.

The Club will be hosting another Tri-County Shoot on September 15th. We are looking to add a "long shot" competition. It would be great to see more club members come on down and enjoy the course. We will need the support of our members again to run the event, from registration, target set up, contest monitor and kitchen help. At the conclusion of the event we will need help to bring in all of the targets. Members, who have an ATV, would be most appreciated if you can come by. To help with the event please arrive to club by 6:45 am. To assist in breaking down the course, please arrive to club by noon. If you can't spend the day, come for a few hours and help. We have a new addition to our archery program. A target frame has been constructed to hold a bag type target. **Crossbows and compound bows may be used with only field tip bolts and arrows.**The target will be placed on the right side of the trap range and must stay there. You may adjust the yardage by changing your position on the trap platform. The target is placed at 30 yards from the right front edge and 40 yards from the back edge of the trap platform that is not being used. The traditional archery range is still useable. Please sign the archery log when using any of the archery facilities. Thank you.
