4. Products must be picked up on date given or be subject to a late charge of \$5.00.
5. Not responsible for any product not picked up after 7 days of scheduled date.
6. 10 lb. minimum per product for processing.
7. No drop off or pick up between the hours of 10:30 am to 1:30 pm.
