- 2. All meat must be thawed and out of freezer paper. No metal twists.
- 3. Boning Charge \$10.00 per piece. Shoulder, & Hind only.
- 4. Products must be picked up on date given or be subject to a late charge of \$5.00.
- 5. Not responsible for any product not picked up after 7 days of scheduled date.
- 6.10 lb. minimum per product for processing.
- 7. No drop off or pick up between the hours of 10:30 am to 1:30 pm.
