



ARCHERY



RANGE RULES

NO Alcohol or Drug use, DO NOT shoot if impaired

All archers must **SIGN IN** and **OUT** in the log book

Range is available to all members. Junior members must be accompanied by an adult member.

Guests policy: Member must be present and a \$10 fee per guest must be paid for the day.

Guest under 12 years of age - no charge

Place fee(s) in an envelope and place it in the secured mailbox (same as rifle range).

Range is open daily from sunrise to sunset and 3D Course (May – Sept.) sunrise to sunset

Exceptions: Closed for all sanctioned club events

May Turkey Season - Archery Range regular hours

3D Course open 12pm to sunset

Crossbows with field point bolts may be used on the **bag targets** on the Archery Range only.

Field point arrows may be used on the bag targets on the Archery Range, **no broadheads.**

Field point arrows only on the 3D targets (animals), **NO** Crossbows or broadheads on 3D targets.

Broadheads may be used on Styrofoam block targets only the Archery range (hunting season).

Range Safety Officers (RSO) are designated by the club as a position of authority and shooters are required to comply with instructions or direction given by them at any time.

NRA accredited RSOs carry an official identification card.

Yellow chain must be up indicating an active archery range.

Keep the archery range clean and dispose of trash in appropriate containers.

Do not deface any of the targets or frames.

Report any issues / concerns to a member of the archery committee.

SAFETY RULES

Be sure of your target and what is beyond your target.

Do not use damaged bows, crossbows, arrows or bolts (may cause serious injury).

Only shoot at designated targets as intended.

All archers **WILL** Shoot from the same yard marker

Stand behind an active shooter

Keep arrows pointing down range

All archers **WILL NOT** Draw an arrow if someone is down range

Shoot an arrow straight up into the air

Shoot any experimental / unconventional projectiles



3D Course



Same rules as above. Field point arrows only, no crossbows and not broadheads. If a target is down or covered – do not shoot it.

Make sure that the shooting station is clear, and make certain that no one is looking for arrows before shooting. Place bows on racks to indicate that you are at the station.

** Members not complying with these rules will face disciplinary actions and possible expulsion from the club. The Board of Directors will review all complaints and decide on the proper disciplinary action(s) to be taken. **
