It is the hunter's responsibility to know where they are. Hunt only on Bethlehem Property. Respect the boundaries. We have had a slight issue with our neighboring landowners and do not want a problem. Do not cross onto another property without express permission. Do not shoot across the property lines. Be respectful good hunters. And always look beyond the target- be safe.

Pheasant 2021-2022

We have secured the lease of the Hoekstra Farm again this year. We will be holding several additional hunts and will hold a youth hunt. Hunting is from 9a till dark. Remember to keep dogs under control (leashed) until you begin hunting and after you have finished in order to not disturb the farm animal or other hunters. There are cows, calves and ducks, guinea hens, and turkeys raised by the farmer. Any farm animal killed will have to be reimbursed-please don't let this happen. We are also only allowed to hunt pheasant and chukar so no shooting ducks, turkey, rabbits etc. Don't ask the farmer about hunting other species- he has been asked and offered but we can't afford to pay. He does allow several persons to deer hunt. No, we cannot. Enough said. We have expanded hunting to the entire week after stocking (we used to be limited to four days). Also please don't shoot near the cows or across the property borders. Please remember to sign in and sign out- it is really important to provide usage reports. Please come out and help stocking!! Good Hunting. Below is the Stocking schedule and lease rules. The following can also be found on the website is a map of property, directions, rules, and stocking dates.

Bird Lease Rules

- 1. Lease hunting hours are 9am till sunset
 - a. Lease use is the release dates and the week following.
 - b. Lease is for birds only- no other game is authorized.
- 2. Lease is for club members only- no guests or family members allowed.
- 3. All members must sign in, record dates and times, record take and sign out.
- 4. Members must wear club button during hunting.
- 5. Members must have NYS hunting license, display back tag and wear hunter orange.
- 6. Eye protection must be worn.
- 7. All firearms must remain unloaded until safely in the fields.
- 8. No hunting or discharge within 500 feet of house.
- 9. All dogs must be in control at all times.
 - a. Aggressive or out of control dogs will be asked to leave.
- Be aware farm has cows, ducks, guinea hens and domestic turkeys.
- 11. Keep the lease clean
 - a. Pick up empty shot shell hulls
 - b. Remove garbage-if you brought it in, take it out.



- 12. All members must sign out and record take and time.
- 13. Park in allocated parking area.
- 14. Head of stocking work detail will sign off on work hours.
 - a. Members must present membership card at time of work detail.
- 15. Members not complying with rules may face <u>DISCPLINARY</u>

 <u>ACTIONS AND POSSIBLE EXPULSION FROM THE CLUB.</u> The Board of Directors will review any complaints and has final decision.
- 16. No use of the property for any reason other than authorized bird hunting.
- 17. Bird Limit is 2 pheasant daily and 2 chukar daily.

Badges must be worn at all times.


Limit is 2 Pheasant and 2 chukar per day per person.

ARCHERY RANGE

Sign in when you use the range or 3D course (RED MAILBOX).

There is a new sign in station at the range and the \$10 guest fee is in effect. Please use the envelopes and place the envelope with the fee in the mailbox. The range is looking good, there are yard markers for 20, 30, 40, 50 & 60 yards. The archery range is currently open from sunrise to sunset. Crossbows may be used on the range (bag targets only). Use crossbow bolts and arrows with field points only. Styrofoam blocks that have been tied together are on the range and may be used as a target for broadheads. The yellow chain is to stay up as a caution to designate a possible live archery range.





3D RANGE


The 3D course is closed. All the targets have reported to the infirmary for a well-deserved rest.


