## ARCHERY RANGE

**Sign in when you use the range or 3D course at the sign in station. Guests must pay a \$10 fee and be accompanied by a regular member.** There is a new broadhead target, surrounded by the Styrofoam. The archery range is currently open from sunrise to sunset. Crossbows may be used on the range (bag targets only). Use crossbow bolts and arrows with **field points only**. The yellow chain is to stay up to designate a possible live archery range.
