



ARCHERY



Archery is believed to be the first step in the shooting sports. This is where the youth are first exposed to how much fun and challenging the shooting sports can be.

Our facility includes a 60-yard range and a 28-station 3D course. Members are required to sign in and out when using the range and/or 3D course. Members may bring a guest(s). There is a \$10 guest fee and the member must be present and will be responsible for the actions of their guest(s).

Archery Committee

The Archery Committee at Bethlehem Rod & Gun Club is very active. The Committee's goal is to expose the youth to the outdoors and to encourage others to enjoy the sport of archery through education, instruction in a safe and fun environment and shooting events. Each archery event is supported by volunteers who are dedicated to the advancement of archery as a means to build confidence in young children and individuals who are new to archery.

The work of the archery committee includes the design, construction and maintenance of the 3D course, maintain the range and develop programs for our members. The Archery committee is always looking for new members and volunteers to assist with all the archery events and programs.

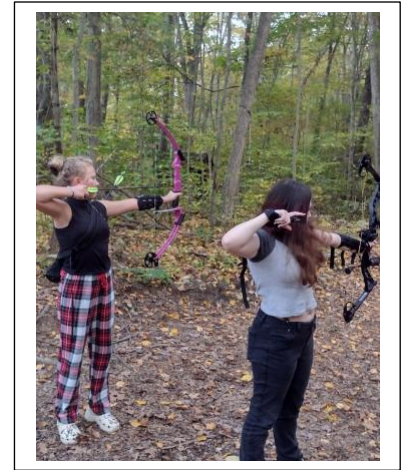
Archery Range

The Archery Range is a 60-yard range with yard markers every 10 yards. The main range includes four large bag targets for bows and crossbows using field points, a large block target for beginners, a broadhead target (during hunting season) and a moveable block target (used for shooting from one line at different distances at the same time). On occasion, a 3D target is set out for the members and guests to use.

3D Shoots

The 3D course has evolved over the years and currently occupies the side of a large ridge and the western side of our lake. This gives us a very scenic, well wooded terrain with a variety of elevation changes. We allow the terrain to dictate the placement of our targets with the intent to mimic real life scenarios. The club is proud to display Rinehart targets. Our 3D shoots are open to the general public. The course has 28 stations with approximately 45 targets. Only field point arrows are permitted on the 3D course. The course is open to the members from May through September.

We look forward to new members becoming familiar with the course and the property through sharing of the work load and participating in the shoots. All the 3D shoots are on Sundays. We set up on the Saturday before the shoot. Registration for the shoots is Sunday morning at 7:00am to 12:00 noon. We collect a couple of targets, bring in the signs and general clean up and end approximately 3pm.
