Sign in and out when you use the Archery Range or 3D Course at the sign in station. Guests must pay a \$10 fee and be accompanied by a regular member.

ARCHERY RANGE

The archery range is currently open from sunrise to sunset. There is a new target made from blocks of Styrofoam located on the 10 yard line. This target is there for young shooters and enables people to shoot at 10 and 20 yards at the same time from the same shooting line. Broadhead target is available for use. Crossbows may be used on the range (**bag targets only**). Use crossbow bolts and arrows with **field points only**. The yellow chain is to stay up to designate a possible live archery range. Need people to cut grass on the range and general clean up on the archery range and 3D course for work hours.

The 3D Course is currently closed sunrise till noon through the month of May due to turkey season.

Archery Tips

Focus compass

How: Use the impact of the previous arrow to determine which part of your technique you pay particular focus to on your next shot. As an example, if the arrow lands high or low, focus on anchor point. If the arrow lands left or right, focus on head position and stance.
